

New Resources for Teaching and Learning

We are thrilled to announce some exciting developments at our school:

- Interactive Panels: The Board of Management has recently acquired and installed five new Interactive Panels, one for each mainstream class that previously did not have one. Additionally, training sessions have been organised for all school staff to ensure effective utilisation.
- 2. Chromebooks: To enhance and expand our digital learning framework, we have acquired 30 Chromebooks. To facilitate convenient charging and storage, we have also acquired a charging trolley for all these devices.
- Charging Trolley for Nuala Building: In the Junior Campus (Nuala Building), we have obtained a second charging trolley specifically for our iPads. This will streamline the charging and storage process.

This represents a significant investment in improving the teaching and learning experience at our school.


The judging for the Pumpkin Carving Contest will also take place at this event with prizes for best junior and senior school entry.





Christmas Panto 'Elfie Saves Christmas'


