


Nature Heroes Update



Under no circumstances are pupils to have mobile phones, cameras, iPods, or any other devices at



When a pupil is absent due to illness or for other reasons parents must inform the class teacher in writing stating the reason for absence, otherwise it will be documented as unexplained.


