

This is an area to showcase the children's achievements and to reward positive actions, behaviours and contributions to school life.



Mobile Phones/ Internet Access


I wish to encourage families to monitor student activity online if it applies to your child/ Children, particularly conversations/posts on phones and devices and websites/ apps your child might be accessing.


