

I'd like to start by saying the Parent's association thank everyone for turning up and showing such strong support for the St Patrick's Day Parade, although a month away



Fifth and Sixth Class were extremely lucky to have had the opportunity to work with Basketball Ireland over the last four weeks.


To mark the end of our very successful 'Run Around Europe', the senior classes enjoyed a leisurely walk along the Bank Walk on the last day of term.
