The following are the main issues dealt with at the recent board meeting of Scoil Aodh Rua agus Nuala

- Staff leave was discussed.
- Treasurer shared a report on finance.
- Staffing was discussed.
- Wellbeing is the focus of School Self Evaluation this year. The Wellbeing Team (comprising of teachers and SNAs) are developing a three-year plan to introduce new initiatives. Surveys completed by staff, students and parents have been analysed and information collated. This information will inform the work of the school moving forward.
- Policies reviewed – Acceptable Use Policy Updated/ Assessment Policy reviewed
- Information Brochure sent out to all local childcare providers as well as all families in our school. This includes information about our school.
- STEM and Digital Learning Plan are being reviewed. An inventory of resources is being drawn up.

- The Special Needs Unit is being renamed. Consultation and collaboration to achieve this.
